In a future email, I'll be sharing with you information on what will be presented during the exhibition's Artists' Reception on Saturday June 18th sometime soon. I would do so now, but we're still booking poets to present their words during the event. Michael Harron produced and directed numerous plays including one I was in over 30 years ago. The service was very fitting as it had both laughter and tears which reflects every human life including his. Although our life experiences left us little opportunity to be in contact with each other on a frequent basis, I will miss his spirit that was felt while he was alive. Yet, the life embodied in his love for the arts goes on as is evident whenever we look within our hearts discovering our own.

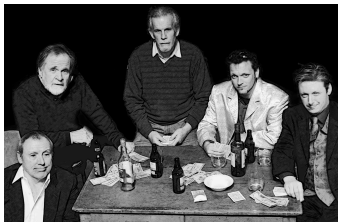

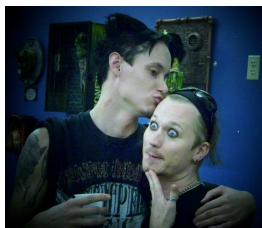
