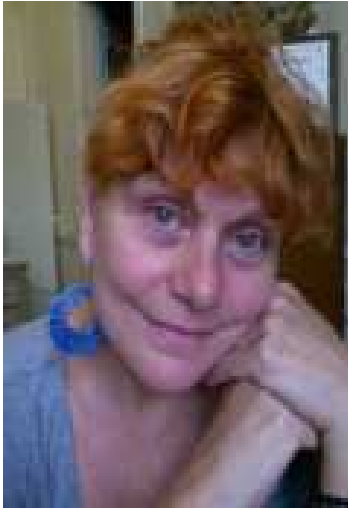


A Forwardian Artist
